How to Turn Abstract words into an image

- What is the first image that comes to mind when I read this word? (Eg. GST)
- 2. Symbolization (Eg. Hot = Coffee)
- 3. Break it in to words (Eg. Catastrophic)
- 4. Sounding (Eg. Karma = car)

Seriously, Can you come up with an image for any word?

Consider this word: **ELECTROENCEPHALOGRAPHICALLY**.

I would break the word like this:

ELECTRO + ENCEPHALO+ GRAPHICALLY.

ELECTRO leads to **electricity** leads to **image of wire**

ENCEPHALO: Last part "Phalo" has a sound of "File". It leads to image of "File"


GRAPHICALLY has a word "Graph", mathematics term. It leads to image of my mathematics professor.

Final image is: A HUGE wire wrapped around a HUGE File and the file is burning and my TINY mathematics professor is trying to pick it up.


